Application Checklist

For Students in Health, Human Services, STEM, and Related Fields
Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians and Lake County Tribal Health Consortium

This form is an application checklist for the LCTHC Member Tribe Scholarship, funded by the Lake County Tribal Health Consortium on behalf of Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians.

Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians will offer 10 scholarship[s] of \$2000.00 to full-time undergraduate or graduate students who are members or the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians or its community, and who have declared a major in the fields of health, medicine, nursing, human and social services, dentistry, psychiatry, pharmacology, public health, STEM fields related to health or health outcomes, or cultural studies intended to support clinical or other health outcomes for Native American or other Indigenous communities.

The application deadline is October 31, 2025. Any incomplete or late applications will not be eligible for awards.

Scholarship recipients will not receive direct compensation; funds will be paid directly to the school of enrollment.

The application requires the following documentation:

- ☒ Certification of tribal membership in the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians or other documentation that the applicant is a member of another tribe, a California Indian, Native American, or Alaska Native *and* is considered a member of the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians' community.
- ☒ Proof of enrollment in a full-time undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited institution.
- ☒ Proof of a declared major or pursuit of study in an eligible field as described above, or related to services provided by LCTHC as described at <https://www.lcthc.com/services/>.
- ☒ A current transcript from the student's college or graduate school showing a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the latest term or cumulatively of all terms at the school. Applicants who are undergraduates entering their first year must provide a high school transcript.
- ☒ Personal Statement

By submitting an application, Applicants agree to maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher during the academic year, and agree to be contacted by LCTHC for recruitment or other purposes. Scholarships are a one-time grant, but successful applicants are eligible to re-apply in future years if the Scholarship is still available.
