Eligibility:

- Must be a member of the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians.
- Maintain a good GPA of 2.0 or Higher.
- Declare a major in the fields of health, medicine, nursing, human and social services, dentistry, psychiatry, pharmacology, public health, STEM fields related to health or health outcomes, or cultural studies intended to support clinical or other health outcomes for Native American or other Indigenous communities.

By submitting an application, Applicants agree to maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher during the academic year and agree to be contacted by LCTHC for recruitment or other purposes. Scholarships are a one-time grant, but successful applicants are eligible to re-apply in future years if the Scholarship is still available. Failure to complete the program will make the applicant ineligible for future scholarships from LCTHC and SVBPI.



Required Supporting Documents:

Certification of tribal membership in the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians or other documentation that the applicant is a member of another tribe, a California Indian, Native American, or Alaska Native *and* is considered a member of the Scotts Valley Band of Pomo Indians' community.

Proof of enrollment in a full-time undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited institution.

Proof of a declared major or pursuit of study in an eligible field as described above or related to services provided by LCTHC as described at <https://www.lcthc.com/services/>.

A current transcript from the student's college or graduate school shows a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the latest term or cumulatively of all terms at the school. Applicants who are undergraduates entering their first year must provide a high school transcript.

Personal Statement Essay:

- Write a 300-word essay about your goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve them.
- Include how your Native American heritage is important to you.

Scholarship recipients will not receive direct compensation; funds will be paid directly to the school of enrollment.
